COVID19 update

- Principal Bowman-White sending out regular COVID19 update emails, with the last one explaining how to access at-home enrichment packets.
- Fielded questions:
 - How many families not at school? No numbers available at this time.
 - Maple administration asked how can we support students not coming to school? So teachers came together to create supplemental lessons.
 - Does Maple need a deep clean? No need in deep clean at Maple; custodian staff is working very hard and doing a terrific job.

 - 2 scenarios 1) student or staff in contact which warrants a closure for deep clean;
 2) confirmed case at school warrants a school closure.

 - Are parent volunteers needed to supervise handwashing time? Families are welcome but teachers are doing a great job.
 - Do teachers have the supplies they need? Yes, a shipment from the district arrived.
 - What do teachers/staff need most right now? To feel supported and loved right now by the community.
 - Bao Ng to start a signup for parents to bring in items/snacks for custodial staff, front office staff, the nurse, etc. Amendment: members from the Family Racial Equity Engagement (FREE) group are putting together a Maple Free Food Pantry to provide food for families during this time.
